### **About the Job:**

MIA is involved in a project on sector own control of mutual microinsurance schemes. The project aims to develop a concept for sector own control in mutual microinsurance. Such self-supervision (sector own control) is in the interest of the members as it protects them as clients but also as owners of their cooperative/SHG involved in insurance. The concept and indicators should be developed in close dialog with stakeholders in the sector, including regulatory parties. At best, the supervision concept will enhance the effectiveness of adequate regulations.

### **Job Description:**

The incumbent will report to the Director (Research & Training), and will deal with above outlined project, including:

- Preparation of a review on the experience with sector own control in different countries;
- Coordination with stakeholders in the microinsurance and regulation space;
- Definition of key indicators for supervision;
- Development of a concept for sector own control (self-supervision);
- Any other related task as instructed to by the responsible supervisor.

### Qualifications required:

- A commitment to MIA's mission and values
- A Master's degree in a relevant field, preferably Law, Economics, actuarial background or related subjects;
- Solid understanding of regulatory approaches and supervision systems to control regulations;
- Very good writing and speaking communication skills in English;
- At least 7 years' professional experience, out of which at least 5 should be related to regulation and supervision;
- Analytical skills;
- Understanding of grassroots institutions and Self Help Groups (SHGs);
- Ability to think "out-of-the-box" and develop innovative solutions;
- Ability to work independently within tasks assigned, and as part of a team in terms of collaborative climate and dedication to deliver results;
- Proficient computer skills (the MIA is transitioning towards an open-source environment);
- Demonstrated high professional and ethical standards.
